Registration Deadline – August 15, 2014

The Foothills Quilters Guild Quilt Show is an open judged show with ribbons awarded in each category as well as ribbons for Best of Show – large quilt, Best of Show – small quilt, Best Hand Quilting, Best Machine Quilting, Artistic Merit, Best Scrap Quilt, and Viewer’s Choice.

Registering your quilt:

1. You must submit one completed registration form for **each** quilt entered. The registration form may be photocopied.
2. Please select the appropriate category for each quilt. If you do not want your quilt judged, please check the box noting this on the form.
Note: If necessary, the Foothills Quilters Guild reserves the right to move your entry to the correct category during the take-in process.
3. All quilts will be registered under the **name of the person who signs at the bottom of the form.**
4. There is a **\$10.00 fee per entry** except for members of the Foothills Quilters Guild, Young Quiltmakers under the age of 18 and Antique Quilts for Bed Turning.
5. Checks should be made out to **Foothills Quilters Guild**, and mailed with the registration form. Your registration fee includes admission to the show for the person entering the quilt.
6. Your quilt will not be accepted for the show unless the **“Hold Harmless”** agreement has been signed and dated. (see registration form)

Category Rules:

Each quilt must consist of three components: top, batting, and back held together with stitching (excluding other techniques).

Large Pieced Hand Quilted – made and quilted by one person. Total of all sides greater than 200” and more than 50% pieced.

Large Pieced Machine Quilted – made and quilted by one person. Total of all sides greater than 200” and more than 50% pieced.

Small Pieced Hand Quilted – made and quilted by one person. Total of all sides less than 200” and more than 50% pieced. (Includes pieced crib quilts, lap quilts and wall hangings)

Small Pieced Machine Quilted – made and quilted by one person. Total of all sides less than 200” and more than 50% pieced. (Includes pieced crib quilts, lap quilts and wall hangings)

Appliquéd Quilts – made and quilted by one person and more than 50% appliquéd. (Stained Glass quilts should be included in this category).

Miniature Quilts – pieced and/or appliquéd and made by one person. Category not determined by size alone. Must be a small version of a full-sized quilt or wall hanging. Maximum block size is 5” and the longest side of the quilt must be no more than 30”.

Other Techniques – examples of this category will include whole cloth quilts, yo-yo quilts, more than 50% embroidered and/or heavily embellished quilts, crazy quilts, cathedral window quilts, and quilts with very special techniques.

Art Quilts – quilts that are an original design made by one person. Quilt shall not be a copy of an existing work or a commercial pattern and may be contemporary or traditional.

Group Quilts – quilts made by two or more people. Includes all techniques and sizes ranging from miniature to large. Block exchange quilts and round robin quilts should be included in this category.

Novelty – includes clothing, placemats, table runners, etc.

Foothills Quilters Guild Celebrates Blount County Challenge – Category is limited to Foothills Quilters Guild members only and must comply with published guidelines.

Young Quiltmakers’ Quilts – all quilts made by quilters under the age of 18 or students in grade 12 or under and first quilts for new quilters regardless of age. Entire quilt must be pieced and quilted or tied by the Young Quiltmaker. The age of the young quilter is required and will be listed in the program. For first quilt entries, please note on the registration instructions that this is a first quilt.

Quilt Preparation:

- 1. Sleeve** – All quilts (with exception of miniatures smaller than 12”) must have a 4” sleeve at the top of the quilt. The sleeve must be hand stitched on the top and bottom of the sleeve with stitches not visible from the front. **If your quilt does not have a sleeve, it will be rejected at take-in.**
- 2. Quilt Owner’s Label** – Each quilt must have a fabric I.D. label with the owner’s name (as listed on the registration form) legibly printed in permanent ink or stitched to the quilt. Any reference to the maker must be covered during the judging phase. Anything identifying your entry on the front or back of the quilt should be basted over with a piece of muslin. This muslin will be removed before the quilt is viewed by the public.

Antique Quilt Registration for Bed Turning

To submit an antique quilt for the Bed Turning Sessions, please complete the “Antique Quilt Information” form on the back of the “Quilt Registration Form” and mail to Joyce Burdine. The antique quilts will be checked in and returned at the same time as all other entries.

Check-in:

All quilt entries must be checked in on **Tuesday, September 16, 2014**, between the hours of 2:00 pm and 5:00 pm at New Providence Presbyterian Church, Maryville, Tennessee

Quilt Return:

All quilts must remain on display until the end of the show. Quilt pick-up will begin on **Saturday, September 20, 2014**, no earlier than 5:00 pm after the close of the show. Quilt owners are required to present their quilt owner’s receipt at the time of pick-up.
